THIS CASE IS SET FOR HEARING ON Request for findings re: special immigrant juvenile status by Araceli Ocampo; former minor: Jose Solano; age 18

THE FOLLOWING ISSUES AND/OR DEFICIENCIES IN THE PAPERS ARE NOTED-

1. Petitioner, Araceli Ocamp (stepmother) requests that the court issue an order finding that minor is eligible for special immigrant juvenile status under the Special Immigrant Juvenile Status Statute (SIJS), 8 U.S.C., § 1101(a)(27)(J), which provides in relevant part as follows:
  - a. "The term 'special immigrant' means ... an immigrant who is present in the U.S.-
    - i. who has been declared dependent on a juvenile court located in the United States or whom such a court has legally committed to, or placed under the custody of, an agency or department of a State, or an individual or entity appointed by a State or juvenile court located in the United States, and whose reunification with 1 or both of the immigrant's parents is not viable due to abuse, neglect, abandonment, or a similar basis found under State law;
    - ii. for whom it has been determined in administrative or judicial proceedings that it would not be in the alien's best interest to be returned to the alien's or parent's previous country of nationality or country of last habitual residence; and
    - iii. in whose case the Secretary of Homeland Security consents to the grant of special immigrant juvenile status..."

2. The specific findings required under the statutory scheme would be: (1) that petitioner is an immigrant placed under the custody of an individual appointed by a state court (probate guardianship); (2) that petitioner's reunification with one or both parents is not viable due to abandonment; and (3) it is not in the petitioner's best interest to be returned to his/her home country.
3. Once the above findings are made, petitioner may then begin the process with the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services to obtain legal permanent residence status. In other words, the findings requested are a prerequisite to filing a petition for a "green card."
4. State Superior Courts have jurisdiction to make factual findings of eligibility under SIJS See *N.O. v. Super. Ct. of Calif.*, County of Alameda, No. A122430 at 2-3 (Cal. Ct. App. 9/25/08). Thus, under the federal legislation, any superior court judge would have jurisdiction to hear the SIJS petition
5. **Petitioner Araceli Ocampo** offers a declaration in support of the requested findings stating, inter alia, the following:
  - a. Former minor was born on **12/03/99** in **Hondura** and lived there with minor's parents until 2001 when mother abandoned former minor with his paternal grandmother. Mother's whereabouts have been unknown ever since.
  - b. Former minor's father resides in the US, and his paternal grandmother is elderly with deteriorating health.
  - c. Minor does not believe he can return to minor's parents because **mother** abandoned him, Father resides in U.S., and his native county of Honduras too dangerous to stay in.
6. Per the statutory scheme, this petition is to proceed only if guardianship of the minor is granted pursuant to the accompanying petition.
7. **Need** notice to former minor (Jose Solano), Jose Romero (father), and Ruth Aguirre (mother). Note: consent and waivers filed as to petition for guardianship, but not as to SIJS petition. **JTD**

THIS CASE IS SET FOR HEARING ON Request for findings re: special immigrant juvenile status, **former minor Quan Ngo (age 20)**

THE FOLLOWING ISSUES AND/OR DEFICIENCIES IN THE PAPERS ARE NOTED-

1. Petitioners, Minh and Oanh Hoang, adoptive parents of former minor, Quan Ngo (age 20) request that the court issue an order finding that minor is eligible for special immigrant juvenile status under the Special Immigrant Juvenile Status Statute (SIJS), 8 U.S.C., § 1101(a)(27)(J), which provides in relevant part as follows:
  - a. "The term 'special immigrant' means ... an immigrant who is present in the U.S.-
    - i. who has been declared dependent on a juvenile court located in the United States or whom such a court has legally committed to, or placed under the custody of, an agency or department of a State, or an individual or entity appointed by a State or juvenile court located in the United States, and whose reunification with 1 or both of the immigrant's parents is not viable due to abuse, neglect, abandonment, or a similar basis found under State law;
    - ii. for whom it has been determined in administrative or judicial proceedings that it would not be in the alien's best interest to be returned to the alien's or parent's previous country of nationality or country of last habitual residence; and

- iii. in whose case the Secretary of Homeland Security consents to the grant of special immigrant juvenile status...”
2. The specific findings required under the statutory scheme would be: (1) that petitioner is an immigrant placed under the custody of an individual appointed by a state court (probate guardianship); (2) that petitioner’s reunification with one or both parents is not viable due to abandonment; and (3) it is not in the petitioner’s best interest to be returned to his/her home country.
3. Once the above findings are made, petitioner may then begin the process with the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services to obtain legal permanent residence status. In other words, the findings requested are a prerequisite to filing a petition for a “green card.”
4. State Superior Courts have jurisdiction to make factual findings of eligibility under SIJS See *N.O. v. Super. Ct. of Calif., County of Alameda*, No. A122430 at 2-3 (Cal. Ct. App. 9/25/08). Thus, under the federal legislation, any superior court judge would have jurisdiction to hear the SIJS petition
5. **Petitioners** offer a declaration in support of the requested findings stating, inter alia, the following:
  - a. Minor was born on 01/28/98, in Vietnam and lived there with minor’s biological parents until 2014.
  - b. Minor was abused and neglected by his biological parents when they sent him to the United States alone at the age of 15 to study abroad.
  - c. Minor was adopted by petitioners on or about 1/21/14, in Dallas, Texas. *It does not appear former minor qualifies for SIJS findings. JTD*
6. Per the statutory scheme, this petition is to proceed only if guardianship of the minor is granted pursuant to the accompanying petition. *However, accompanying petition does not appear to be proper as proposed guardians have already adopted minor. JTD*
