Nancy Eberhardt has over 26 years of experience working in California courts, with the last 8.5 years in executive leadership as Assistant Executive Officer in the Superior Court of San Diego County and Deputy Court Executive Officer with the San Bernardino Superior Court.

She is a member of the Judicial Council’s Advisory Committee on Providing Access and Fairness and the Court Executive Advisory Committee. She serves as certified faculty for the National Center for State Courts Fundamentals of Caseflow Management and High Performing Courts courses. Ms. Eberhardt served as consultant for the CEB Special Needs Trusts Practice Guide and previously served several terms on the Judicial Council’s Probate Advisory Committee.

Nancy Eberhardt received her Bachelor of Arts degree from University of San Diego and holds a post graduate Paralegal Certificate, General Litigation, from the University of San Diego.
