NEW PRESIDING JUDGE TO BEGIN TWO YEAR TERM IN SUPERIOR COURT OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

San Bernardino – Judge Raymond L. Haight III will become the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino on January 1, 2016.

Judge Haight has served as the Assistant Presiding Judge since January 2014 and has served on several court committees while also hearing a daily criminal trial calendar in the Victorville Courthouse. In June 2015 he was selected by his fellow judges to succeed Judge Marsha G. Slough as the Presiding Judge.

Judge Haight earned his Juris Doctorate from the California Western Law School and a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Southern California.

Judge Haight began his career as a Juvenile Court Referee in 1997 and as a Court Commissioner in 1999. He was appointed a Judge of the Superior Court by Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger in 2005.

Prior to joining the bench, he began his legal career as deputy county counsel for Kern County in 1975. In 1978, he became a deputy district attorney for San Bernardino County, where he served until 1995.

Also effective January 1, 2016, Judge John P. Vander Feer will become the Assistant Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino.

Judge Vander Feer earned his Bachelor of Arts Degree in 1985 from Point Loma College in San Diego and his Juris Doctorate Degree in 1989 from the University of Pacific, McGeorge School of Law in Sacramento.

Judge Vander Feer was appointed to the bench in 1998 and currently hears a probate calendar in the San Bernardino Historic Courthouse. He will soon be moving to the Victorville Courthouse where he will be the Supervising Judge and hear a criminal calendar
