Judge Mary E. Fuller to Retire

Judge Mary E. Fuller has announced she will be retiring sometime before the end of her term on December 31, 2016.

Judge Fuller is currently assigned at the Rancho Cucamonga district hearing a Criminal calendar. Her previous assignments include Juvenile, Civil, Family Law and Probate calendars. She was also assigned to the Appellate Department from 1999 to 2003, and sat as Presiding Judge of the Appellate Department from 2001 to 2003.

Judge Fuller was appointed to the Municipal Court, West District, on February 25, 1997 by Governor Pete Wilson. Due to unification, Judge Fuller was elevated to the Superior Court on August 10, 1998. She began her legal career as a Deputy District Attorney in 1972 with the County of San Bernardino.

Throughout her career, Judge Fuller has served on many local and statewide committees and has served in several leadership roles. She was a member of the California Judges Board of Directors from 2003 to 2005, representing San Bernardino, Riverside and Orange counties. She has served as Vice President and President of the California Judges Foundation; and since 2008, has been a member of the California Judges Association's Ethics Committee, serving as Vice Chair and currently as Chair.

Locally, Judge Fuller has served on the San Bernardino court's Civil, Community Outreach, Oversight Collections, and Executive committees.

Fuller earned a Juris Doctor degree from UCLA Law School and a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of California, Riverside.

The retirement of Judge Fuller creates a vacancy that will be an open seat in the 2016 election.
