Reopening

Rancho Cucamonga Courthouse will reopen to the public Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Face coverings and social distancing required.

June 1

Walk up window & drop off box requirement

The public is required to use the outside walk-up window for payments and process paperwork.

The public should use the drop box available 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for non-cash payments, pleadings, proof of completion, and other documents except for CCP 170.1 and 170.6 filings.

June 1

Court Hearings Begin

Hearings for criminal matters will begin at staggered sessions at 8:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m., and 2:00 p.m. Litigants will be allowed inside the courthouse within 30 minutes of their scheduled hearing. Those with misdemeanor cases must check-in with the Public Defender outside the west entrance of the courthouse.

Only jurors, litigants with felony matters on calendar including their attorney, those conducting business with the other agencies in the building, and who obtain a pass from the outside walk-up window may be allowed into the courthouse.
